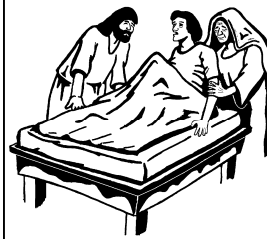

Luke 7

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: I Kings 17:17-24 The power of the true God in the land of the Baals is displayed through the intercession of His prophet Elijah. A widow's grief at the death of her son is ended and her reversal of praise for Elijah ensues.

Psalm 30: "I will praise you Lord for You have rescued me."

Second Reading: Galatians 1:11-19 St. Paul answers any accusations made that his preaching is unauthentic. He also makes explicit his relationship with the "mother Church" through his conferences with Cephas (St. Peter).

Gospel: Luke 7:11-17 One of the more beautiful New Testament stories, this one not only tells us that Jesus was moved to the depths of His heart, but it also conveys His compassion, prompting the use of His unique power. In turn, Luke the physician gives his readers reason to hope in and trust Jesus.

Loving Lord, you are the Lord of all time and space, so I pray for my family through all generations, those who have lived, those who are living, those who are yet to be born. And I ask that you would touch us and heal us, Lord, in all the ways you know we are most in need of healing.

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all of us in your care. Amen.
