



- **B** *Be merciful*. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to
- C Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.
